THEO 511\* addresses the need for language instruction which is exegetically useful but which also lays a foundation so that those who wish to proceed to translation of the Bible from the Hebrew original are suitably prepared. No prior knowledge of Hebrew is assumed. In the Fall semester, a semi-inductive method is used to learn the fundamentals of Biblical Hebrew. By the end of the first semester, the class will have read Genesis 1 in Hebrew.

Students registered in THEO 511\* are expected to attend classes combined with HEBR 191 and a tutorial hour for Theology students only on Mondays in the Fall semester from 9:30-10:30 am.

Assessment models will depend on whether students take THEO 211\* for a Grade Point or on a Credit/Fail basis.

Students taking THEO 211\* for a Grade Point will be expected to fulfill the same requirements as students registered for HEBR 191 in the Fall semester: exercises, memory work, and an end of term test as well as small assignments for the Theology tutorial.

Students in THEO 511 taking the course for a Credit will be expected to obtain a passing grade of 50% in the course combined with HEBR 191 and 50% in the tutorial assignments. Those who elect not to write the final exam because they have achieved the required 50% in HEBR 191 by doing tests and exercises will be required to write an additional tutorial paper besides the tutorial assignments given during the semester.
